This score is awarded by the subject teacher using this criteria

<p>A grade 1 student will</p>	<p>1.1 Always takes responsibility for their learning and shows leadership in supporting the learning of others in a positive manner. 1.2 Be a resourceful learner who uses their own initiative and is independent 1.3 Be reflective about their work and show resilience in seeking to improve the quality of the work they produce. 1.4 Be eager to engage with and leads peers in a respectful manner 1.5 Demonstrate reasoning skills through independent enquiry 1.6 Produce all work to a standard that is complete, accurate and well presented, especially in terms of reading, writing, communication and Mathematics.</p>
<p>A grade 2 student will:</p>	<p>2.1 Usually takes responsibility for their learning. 2.2 Be developing skills to become a more resourceful independent learner. 2.3 Follow instructions and is generally keen to do well. 2.4 Be reflective on how to improve their work and usually respond positively to feedback. 2.5 Usually works hard to produce work that is accurate and well presented in terms of reading, writing, communication and Mathematics. 2.6 Be an effective team member.</p>
<p>A grade 3 student will:</p>	<p>3.1 Be coasting and not reaching full potential. 3.2 Be aware of the need to take responsibility for their own learning but is not always doing so. 3.3 Not always take care with presentation and accuracy of work in terms of reading, writing, communication and Mathematics. 3.4 Enjoys teamwork but does not always help others to learn. 3.5 Be reflective and act upon feedback but do not display the resilience to improve. 3.6 Not always follow instructions the first time. 3.7 Displays poor behaviour and can sometimes disrupt the progress being made. 3.8 Sometimes disrupt the learning of others.</p>
<p>A grade 4 student will:</p>	<p>4.1 Take little responsibility for their own learning. 4.2 Give up when challenged due to a lack of resilience. 4.3 Be ineffective in team work. 4.4 Not respond to feedback. 4.5 Frequently does not follow instructions. 4.6 Frequently disrupts learning. 4.7 Demonstrate a lack of respect to others or themselves.</p>

Homework scores

This score is awarded by the subject teacher using this criteria

A grade 1 student will	HW1.1 Meet all deadlines. HW1.2 Produce homework that is always fully complete, accurate and well presented, especially in terms of RWCM HW1.3 Produce homework to the best of ability.
A grade 2 student will:	HW2.1 Meet almost all deadlines. HW2.2 Produce homework that is usually fully completed, accurate and well presented, especially in terms of RWCM HW2.3 Normally produce homework in line with ability
A grade 3 student will:	HW3.1 Not always meet homework deadlines. HW3.2 Produce homework that is not always complete and /or produced with the level of accuracy and as well presented, especially in terms of RWCM as expected. HW3.3 Produce homework that is sometimes below ability
A grade 4 student will:	HW4.1 Rarely meets deadlines. HW4.2 Produce homework that is poor quality, is usually incomplete and /or poor in terms of accuracy and presentation, especially in terms of RWCM as expected. HW4.3 Frequently produces homework below ability.
