

The NHS has requested us to circulate the email below to our parents:

Please see below for information shared today which I would ask you to share widely across both CCG and Provider networks to ensure all staff are sighted on this potential risk to patients. This information has been reported in the press for some time now but as we have now been made aware of it I would suggest that we take the necessary action to inform frontline practitioners who may be told or hear information which might indicate a patient is considering purchasing a kit.

A CAMHS T4 provider has shared the information below on the Low Secure National Network call today:

A EUTHANASIA campaigner nicknamed Dr Death is selling 'do-it-yourself' suicide kits online.

Dr Philip Nitschke, who wants assisted suicide legalised, disguises the £257 kits as equipment for home-brewing beer.

Colleagues googled/safari/amazon and found reference to a audiobook and article dated 2017

The Chief Nurse and Directors of Nursing in the North West are already aware of this information and have requested that it is shared.
